
## **Treble and Bass Clef Worksheet**

When reading music, the **treble clef** is used for high-sounding notes. In fact, the word "treble"


literally means "high." The treble clef is also called the G clef because it wraps around the note G. The illustration on the right shows the development of the treble clef over the centuries.

The **bass clef** is used for low-sounding notes. The word "bass" means "low." The bass clef is also called the F clef because it wraps around the note F. The illustration on the right shows the development of the bass clef over the centuries.
