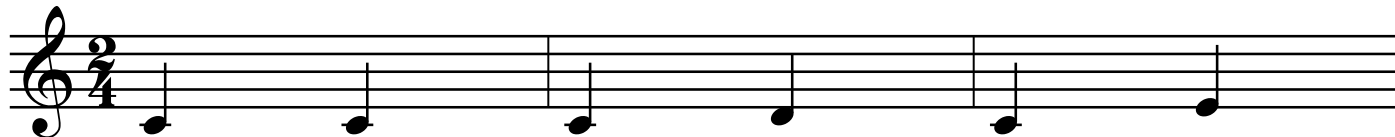


Intervals Worksheet

- An **interval** is the distance between two notes. Being able to identify intervals quickly will greatly improve your skills at reading music. Below are explanations and examples of the intervals we learned about so far:



Unison

When a note is repeated,
the interval is called a unison.

2nd

Two notes just a step
apart are called a 2nd.

3rd

Two notes that are a skip
apart are called a 3rd.
